**Math Update:** Teachers attended a training with District Academic Coach, Darrel Frost, in September on how to improve lesson planning and questioning for student achievement. Students have taken their 1<sup>st</sup> iReady diagnostic assessment and will take the 2<sup>nd</sup> one in January. We have developed a cut score for students that correspond with FSA proficiency.

**ELA Update:** Teachers have been working with Mrs. Wilson, our Reading Coach, on Standards-based lesson planning for Florida Standards alignment infusing content areas and theme. This continues our professional development with Diana Carry of Thinking Core at the beginning of the year. Students have taken the October iReady growth monitoring assessment. Results will be published in each student's AVID binder.
