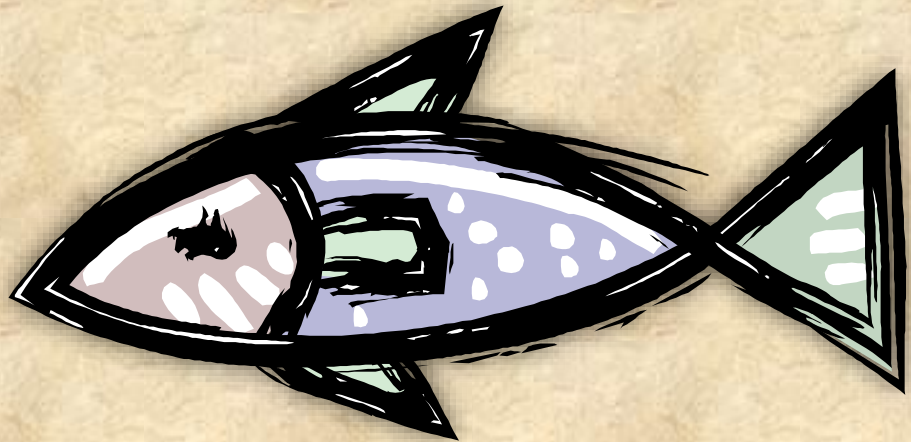

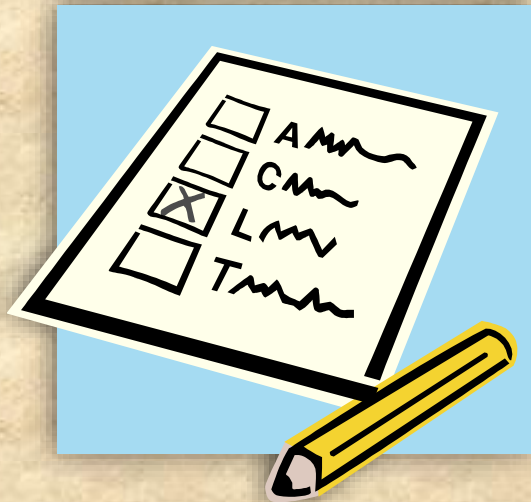


Purpose of the SAC



- The purpose of the SAC is to assist the principal and staff in the development, implementation, and monitoring of the School Improvement Plan (SIP) required in accountability legislation.

SAC Membership



- SAC Members are teachers, parents, and business partners.
- SACs must represent the racial and ethnic makeup of the community served by the school.
- The **majority** of the SAC members, 51% or more, must not be employed by the school district.



SAC Member Responsibilities:

- Working in partnership with the principal and staff:
 - Assist in the development of the School Improvement Plan.
 - Assist in the monitoring of the School Improvement Plan.
 - Assist in making updates to the SIP throughout the school year to reflect current strategy practices, strategy fidelity checks, strategy data checks, student evaluation data, professional development delivered to date and budget updates.
- Follow the school board's approved *Guidelines for School Improvement*, as this document acts as the SAC's bylaws.
- Attend SAC meetings. We must have 80% attendance for 8 monthly meetings to apply to be a 5 Star school.
- Ensure that during SAC meetings all topics of discussion relate directly to the School Improvement Plan.

Purpose of the School Improvement Plan (SIP)
